Burke Community Management (BCM) has requested a waiver of this requirement on our behalf, which may affect how many hours the facility will be available for residents' use. The Board will be considering staffing options depending on the County's response to our request.

Celebrate Holi at Mosaic

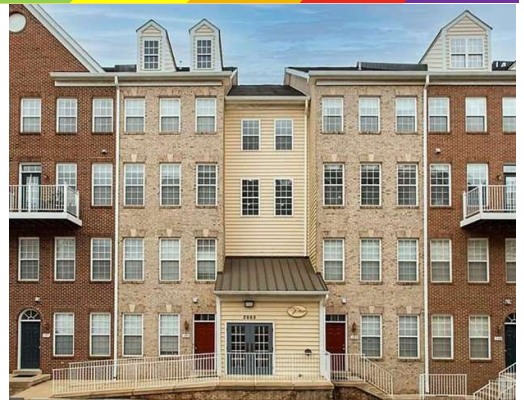
