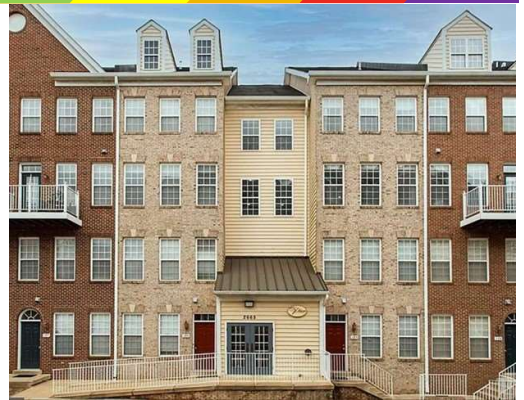

Last month's trivia answer: Monrovia, Liberia, named for 5th President James Monroe, is the only foreign capital named for a US President. Monroe was an ardent supporter of The American Colonization Society (ACS), whose mission was to encourage and support the repatriation of freeborn Black Americans and emancipated slaves to sub-Saharan Africa, i.e., the country eventually known as Liberia. The city was named in his honor in 1824, though Liberia did not attain its political independence until 1846.
