Collection boxes are in the Target Lobby to collect new, unwrapped, toys, games, and books.

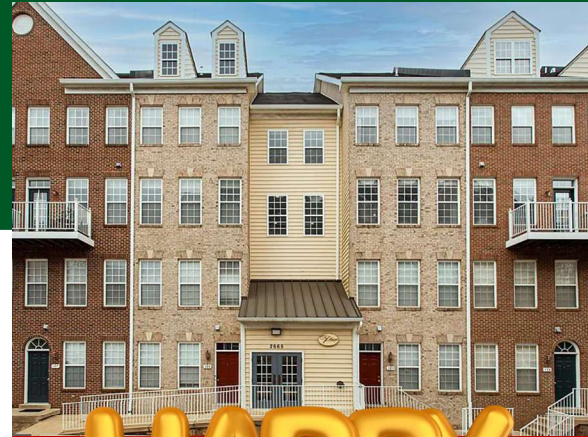
